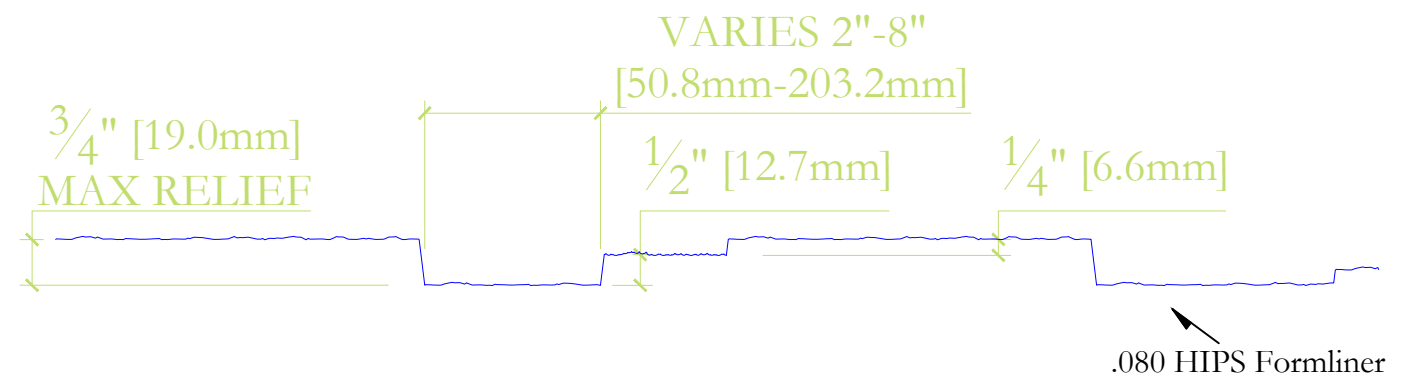
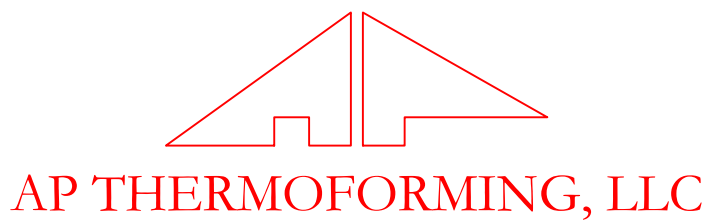


# Typical Section

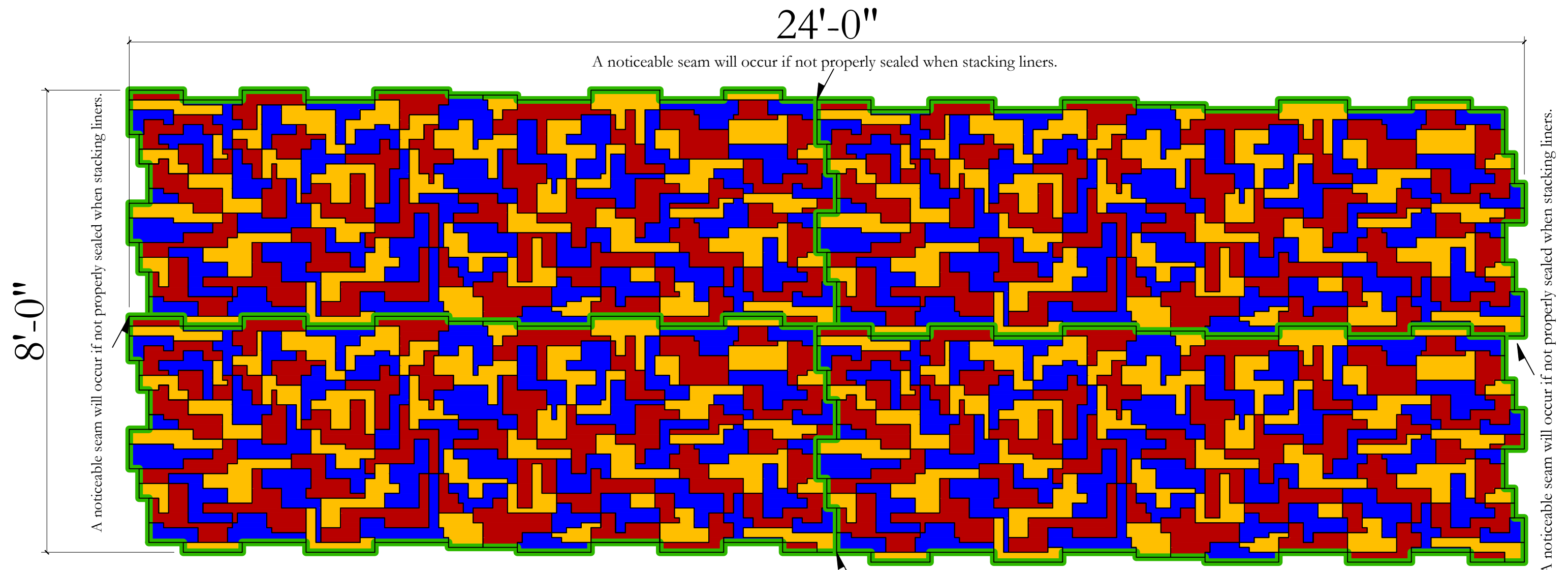

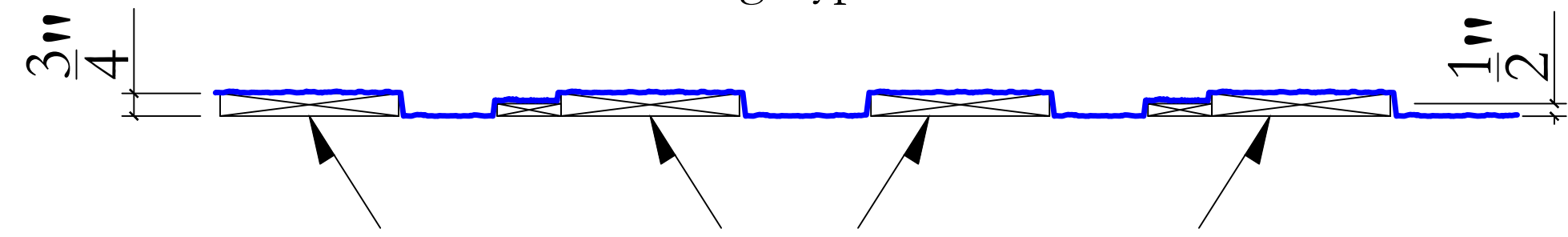

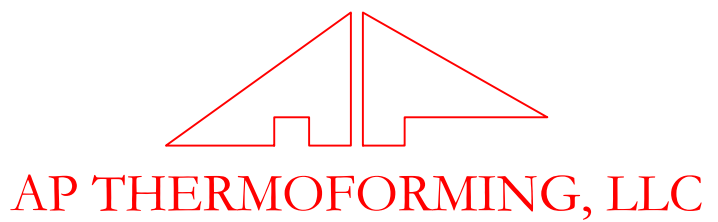
### Seam Backing Typical Section
